I have been a member of Unit 34 Mill Bay Auxiliary Coast Guard since June 2007 and have worked my way up through the Unit first as New Crew, then Crew and Advanced Crew levels. I then attended a 3 day course in Naniamo to be a Station Trainer which I was awarded in Nov. 2009. Then I was nominated to be the first one of our unit to go to the new SARNAV 1 Course in the Simulator at Victoria CCGA-P HQ. This course took place on the water in a Titan 249XL fully enclosed vessel and in the Simulator on base successfully passing the course I was awarded the SARNAV 1 Certificate along with the Small Vessel Operator Proficiency Certificate (SVOP). This 4 day Navigation course is very intense with daytime runs on the water and in the Simulator then night runs on the water and in the Simulator using Raymarine e80 series Chart plotters and Radar screens as our main displays.

After which I was nominated to go to Rigid Hull Inflatable Operator Training (RHIOT School) also passing successfully with Hurricane 753 and 773 Inflatable. Upon returning to the unit I was promoted to the position of Coxswain responsible for a crew of 5-6 crew members in various aspects of training signing of their logs etc as they gain the skills required and I am working on my Coxswain sign off
